The riding paths in and around Hodgemoor have been developed and are maintained by the Hodgemoor Riding Association in cooperation with Forest Enterprise, Bucks County Council, Chiltern District Council, the Brett Environmental Trust and several bodies representing walkers and other users of the woods.

Cyclists and riders have the right in law to use bridle paths. Riders who are members of the Hodgemoor Riding Association may use the permissive trails under the contract between our Association and the Forestry Commission, as may cyclists. Neither riders nor cyclists are allowed on footpaths or any other part of the wood. All motorised vehicles including motorbikes are prohibited, especially as motorbikes have caused sever accidents to other users of the woods (the most recent in March 2011 when the motorcyclists was apprehended by the police). Please phone Amersham police on 0845 850 5505 immediately on seeing a motorbike in the woods.

Please play your part in Hodgemoor's future by joining the association, by participating in clearing parties, and by giving your name when asked by a forest ranger.
