Cyclists Code of Conduct

Cyclists are welcome to use the Public and Permissive Bridleway network (marked with a horseshoe sign) in Hodgemoor Woods. Cyclists should...

- Signal to horse riders and walkers as you approach, with a bell or call
- Give way to other woodland users
- Stick to the trails marked with a horseshoe symbol
- Watch out for wildlife and dogs
- Take any rubbish home
- Help conserve Hodgemoor by joining the Hodgemoor Riding Association

Please note: From the Bottrells Lane car park, cyclists may not ride straight into the woods but must ride east or west on Bottrells Lane and enter using one of the Permissive Trails

Should inconsiderate use by cyclists become a persistent issue, the Forestry Commission reserve the right to modify or withdraw access for cyclists to the permissive trails.
