Photos will be taken on the day of any Xmas outfits (horse or rider or both) and posted on the Hodgemoor Facebook page. Prizes will be awarded on the number of Likes after a week and the judge's assessment. However, dressing up is not obligatory, just correct dressage attire is fine.

IMPORTANT PLEASE NOTE:

In line with Covid-19 guidelines, entry is restricted to **one class only** to avoid overcrowding in the car park and round the arena. Each competitor can only come with one person. Spectators will be allowed in the small viewing area if keeping a 2 metre distance and wearing a mask. Not more than 3 riders in the warm-up arena. Score sheets and rosettes will be available in the Waylands office (only 2 in the office at a time) or bring a SAE if you don't want to wait.

Each participant and their companion must declare on the day that they have not tested positive for Covid-19 nor been in contact with someone who has tested positive, as per the guidelines. Your entry fee will be refunded if you cannot compete due to a Covid-19 issue.

Class 1: Intro A 2008

Section A: For horse/rider combinations that have not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd at Intro level or above

Section B: Any horse/rider combination.

Class 2: Prelim 7 2002

Section A: For horse/rider combinations that have not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd at prelim level or above

Section B: Any horse/rider combination.

Class 3: Prelim18 2006

Section A: For horse/rider combinations that have not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd at prelim level or above

Section B: Any horse/rider combination.

Class 4: PYO Novice 27 2007 or Elementary 44 2002

Section A: For horse/rider combinations that have not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd at novice level or elementary and above

Section B: Any horse/rider combination.

Cost: £15 for the class, £20 if you are not a member of the Hodgemoor Riding Association.
Entries close: 6 p.m. Monday 14th December. Numbers will be limited.
