The Hodgemoor Winter Dressage Series permits the following relaxations because of hacking to the event(s), winter weather and the equipment available to new young riders.

- 1. Jodhpurs and jackets may be of any conservative dark colour providing they are not multicoloured or boldly striped. Hunting or hacking jodhpurs and jackets, including tweed, are permitted. You may keep your raincoat on if rain is falling when you are competing in an outdoor school.
- 2. Back protectors, air jackets and soft shell air jackets in any conservative, muted tone are permitted.
- 3. Horses should not wear boots, leg warmers or bandages when competing.
- 4. Gloves may be any colour.
- 5. A whip is permitted.
- 6. Fancy dress riders must conform to the safety standards.
